Introduction

The aim of this course is to teach the most essential knowledge of Islam that every Muslim must know. Upon completing the Foundation Certificate, you will understand **Islam, Iman and Ihsan**. You will learn the most important personally obligatory religious knowledge that a Muslim living in the modern world needs to know. This will allow you to both deal with and teach the most commonly encountered situations. This course will teach you knowledge using a classical manual and will prepare you for future higher-level studies. The duration of this course is 6 Months.

This knowledge will prepare you to live as a Muslim according to *Shariah* in the modern world, meaning that the material will be taught in a manner that is applicable, relevant and understandable in these times.

Pathways

After the successful completion of the Foundation Certificate I, participants will be eligible to progress to the Foundation Certificate II. The final destination is the Foundation Diploma in

Islamic Studies. Those who wish to teach above subjects after successful completion must take an exam and study a few extra subjects to be considered eligible for teaching.

The Foundation Certificate I – Islamic Studies will enable you to teach new Muslims, children at weekend schools and Islamic schools, students in study groups, and your own children.

Course Details

Essentials of Islam: Learn the fundamentals of belief, worship, and fiqh of inward so that you can gain a high-level understanding of the religion, as well as learn what you need to know immediately to make your purification and prayer valid.

Islamic Belief: Gain the basic knowledge of what a Muslim believes about Allah, His messengers, and the Day of Judgment. Deepen and strengthen your understanding of the core Islamic beliefs through studying the most distinguished and well-known classical manual on Islamic beliefs, the manual of Imam Tahawi.

Islamic Sacred Law Worship Part 1 and 2: achieve a solid grounding in the rulings of purification, prayer, fasting, Zakat, and Hajj. The Hanafi course will be based on Imam Shurunbulali's Noor Al Idah, the Shafi'i course will be based on Imam Nawawi's al-Maqasid, and the Maliki course on Al-Izziyya.

Ihsan (Fiqh of inner self): This course provides an introduction to the discipline of Islamic spirituality. The course will focus on the sickness of the heart and how to remove them, the praiseworthy attribute of the heart and how to nurture them, and the fundamentals of developing good Muslim character.

Quran Tafseer: Tafseer of the short chapters of the Quran.
